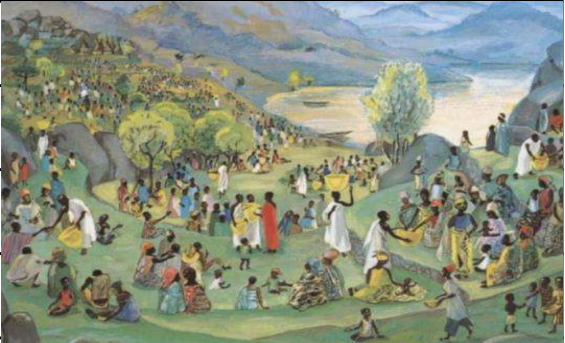




# Christianity 3 - The Life and Teachings of Jesus

Key Vocabulary	
Baptism	A ceremony showing commitment to God.
Disciple	A follower of Jesus.
Faith	Trust in God.
(Good) Samaritan	A charitable person – helping others and teaching kindness.
Kingdom of God	God’s rule in Christians’ lives.
Miracle	An extraordinary event showing God’s power.
Parable	A story with a deep meaning – moral teachings.
Repent	To feel sorry for wrongdoing and turn back to God.
Resurrection	Rising from the dead; Christians believe that Jesus rose on Easter Sunday.
Sermon on the Mount	Jesus’ teaching about how to live.
Sinful	Doing things that go against God’s will.
Temptation	Being encouraged to do something wrong.
Transfiguration	When Jesus’ appearance changed to show his glory.
Trespass	To go against God’s law or wrong someone.



**Key People**  
**Jesus** – Central figure in Christianity; Christians believe he is the Son of God.  
**John the Baptist** – Baptised Jesus in the River Jordan.  
**The 12 Disciples** – Followers chosen by Jesus (including Peter, James, John).  
**Peter, James, and John** – Witnessed the Transfiguration.  
**Moses and Elijah** – Appeared with Jesus during the Transfiguration.

**Key Places**  
**River Jordan** – Where Jesus was baptised.  
**Wilderness** – Where Jesus was tempted for 40 days.  
**Sea of Galilee** – Where Jesus performed miracles like calming the storm.  
**Mount of Beatitudes** – Where Jesus gave the Sermon on the Mount.  
**Mount Tabor** (or a high mountain) – Where the Transfiguration happened.  
**Israel** – The country where Jesus lived and taught.
