<b>Continent</b>	A continent is any one of the seven very large areas of land on the earth.
<b>Journey</b>	An act of travelling from one place to another.
<b>Transport</b>	A way of travelling from one place to another. You can travel using different types of transport, such as cars, buses, trains, boats, planes or bicycles.
<b>Tradition</b>	Something people do again and again over time.
<b>Climate</b>	What the weather is usually like in a place over a long time.
